### **Historical Note**

AHF's Asian expansion began in 2003 in China, and shortly after, in 2004, AHF began working in India as India Cares. They began to serve India with free HIV testing, care, support, and treatment services. AHF opened its free antiretroviral therapy clinic in Delhi in 2005. In 2005, AHF also began Cambodia Cares with the Asian Bureau Chief, Dr. Chhim Sareth along with the Ministry of Health in Cambodia. Services were established in Vietnam by 2007, and Nepal in 2009. AHF works with local partners in healthcare to provide treatment and care services. AHF is currently in 10 countries in Asia, including Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Laos, Myanmar, Nepal, Philippines, Thailand, and Vietnam.
